**“Sleep Book” –Wear your favorite PJ’s**

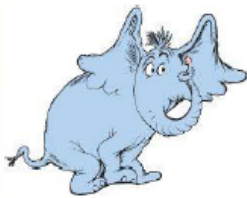
**Tuesday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>**

**After school at 3:00 pm:**

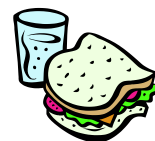
Pick up your student at 3:00 pm sharp

Pick up at designated division door/playground

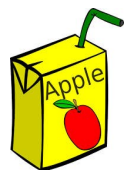
