

Instead, Mrs. Ginter is teaching all of the Grade 5-8 classes once a week, and teaching Music Theory and other Band outcomes that do not require playing a wind instrument. Mrs. Ginter will keep you posted as to when the playing restrictions are lifted, and at that point students will have the option to continue in Band class with an instrument.

#### Let's Go, Band!

The City of Prince Albert has recently updated the Traffic Bylaw to prohibit Uturns in school zones. This change was initiated as a means to improve pedestrian safety in school zones where, as you know, there can be a lot of congestion during the school day. This measure will ensure that each child can see and be seen by drivers in the area. If a vehicle is performing a U-turn, children who are walking, running and playing in the area many not anticipate the change in direction. Similarly, as a driver is performing a U-turn, blind spots change and the driver may not be able to see what is happening behind the vehicle. The Prince Albert Police Service will be handling enforcement of this new regulation. The fine for violating the restriction is \$100. Hello everyone! One month back to school and things are going good. I am so happy to be back and also still able to offer breakfast to everyone in the mornings, even though it looks different this year.

I have had many students ask me about the parfaits we used to serve. I am unable to offer them at this time but I would love to share the recipe with you. You will need yogurt, fresh or frozen berries/fruit and granola. start with the yogurt in the bottom of your bowl, than add the berries/fruit, and lastly top it off with granola and you have yourself a delicious, nutritious breakfast as snack. Here is the recipe I use to make the granola:

Homemade Granola 3 cups of rolled oats 1 cup of coconut 1 teaspoon of cinnamon 3 Tablespoons of Chia seeds 1/4 cup of wheat bran or flax 3/4 cup of maple syrup or honey 1/2 cup of coconut oil 1 egg white

Blend dry ingredients together in its own bowl, and blend wet ingredients together in their own bowl. combine both bowls of ingredients and stir till dry ingredients are coated well. spread on a cookie sheet and bake @ 300F for 45 minutes. But make sure to stir the mixture every 15 minutes. Enjoy!!!

Remind is a free app that lets you communicate with your teachers – right from your phone.


