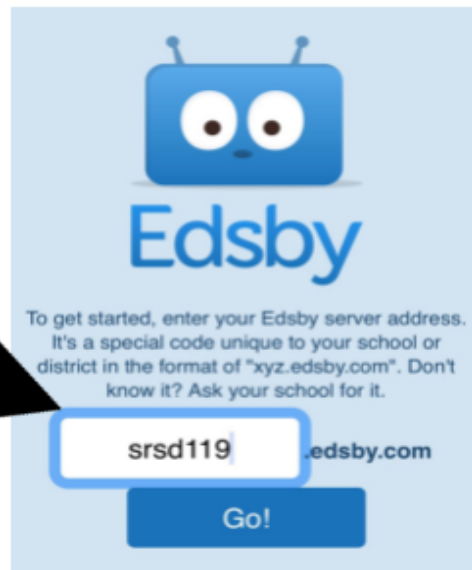
Thank you for your continued support. Let's work together to ensure that February is a month filled with learning, kindness, and courage!

### **Reminder to Parents/Guardians and Students:**

#### **Before school—student drop off at 8:20 am (NO EARLIER THAN 8:20AM):**

- ◇ **Drop off students at their playground muster point (division 1, 2 or 3)**
- ◇ Playground supervisor will let them in the school when the bell goes at 8:35 am
- ◇ **No drop off in the front driveway as a bus drops off students there**

#### **If your child is late, arriving later than 8:35:**

- ◇ Student comes in the front door—knock on the locked door

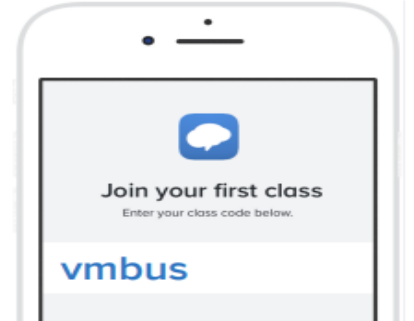

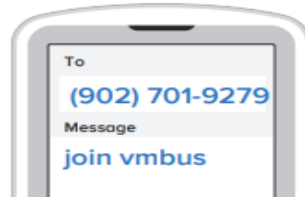
