Reminder to Parents/Guardians and Students:

Before school—student drop off at 8:20 am (NO EARLIER THAN 8:20AM):

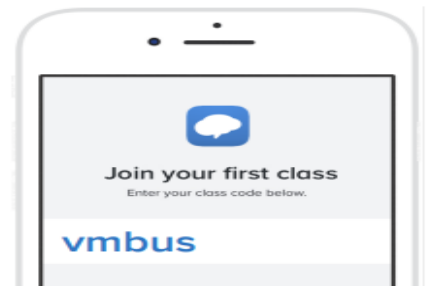

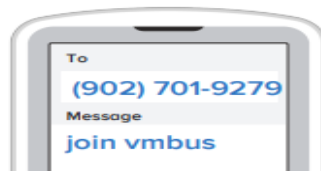
