Reminder to Parents/Guardians and Students:

Before school—student drop off at 8:20 am (NO EARLIER THAN 8:20AM):

- ◇ Drop off students at their playground muster point (division 1, 2 or 3)
- ◇ Playground supervisor will let them in the school when the bell goes at 8:35 am
- ◇ No drop off in the front driveway as a bus drops off students there

If your child is late, arriving later than 8:35:

- ◇ Student comes in the front door—knock on the locked door
- ◇ Make sure their name gets marked down to avoid the attendance call out

After school at 3:00 pm:

- ◇ Pick up your student at 3:00 pm sharp
- ◇ Pick up at designated division door/playground
- ◇ No pick up in the front driveway as a bus picks up students there

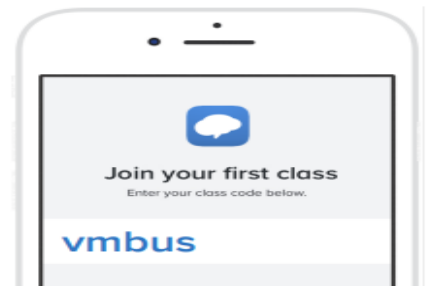

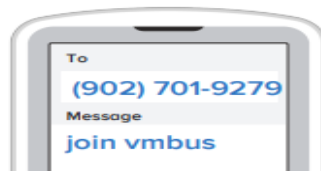
